

Postgraduate Certificate in Religious Education

An exciting and partially funded opportunity for spring 2012, the Postgraduate Certificate in Religious Education is a flexible, one year part-time course, aimed at both specialist and non-specialist RE teachers who are working at any Key Stage or in an advisory capacity. The three module course has been designed to give professionals the opportunity to reflect on current practice, build teaching skills and critical reflection upon them, and deepen their subject knowledge of RE.

Each of the three modules is worth 20 Masters level credits. Modules will address current debates in religious education; issues in religion and approaches to pedagogy in this subject area.

A bursary of £200 per person is available for a limited number of places thanks to funding support from the Diocese of Worcester
